

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

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

## What is a **metabolite**?

A metabolite is a substance that is produced or consumed during a metabolic process. Metabolic processes are biological pathways that involve the conversion of one molecule into another. These processes are carried out by enzymes, which are proteins that catalyze specific chemical reactions. Metabolites can be organic compounds, such as carbohydrates, lipids, proteins, and nucleic acids, or inorganic substances like water and oxygen.


